- Dedicated backup appliance located at your business
- Fast local file and full-system restores
- Best when downtime is expensive or internet is limited
- Higher upfront hardware investment

HYBRID RECOVERY

Most complete protection

- Local backup for speed plus an encrypted offsite copy
- Protection from hardware failure and total-site loss
- Fast local recovery with offsite disaster protection
- Highest overall level of protection and cost
